

How do I get to my digital books after I've downloaded them?

Adobe Reader automatically saves a copy of the downloaded eBook to your computer. To open an Adobe eBook open Adobe Reader and select File > My Bookshelf in Adobe Reader 6.0 or in Adobe Reader 7.0 select File > Digital Editions > My Digital Editions.

OverDrive Media Console automatically saves a copy of the audio book, music, or video title to your computer. In order to listen or view downloaded titles, open OverDrive Media Console and select the desired title from the 'Media Library.'

The Greater Phoenix Digital Library maintains a list of digital media currently checked out to you in 'My Digital Bookshelf' in your digital account. Please use the 'Help' button on the Greater Phoenix Digital Library site and look for the support contacts for assistance if you have problems downloading any media titles.

Can I use digital books on multiple machines?

To use Adobe eBooks on multiple machines, each machine must first be activated to the same account using Adobe's 'Named Activation' option.

OverDrive media titles can be transferred to supported portable devices and burned CDs (when allowed by the publisher) for listening on-the-go. For a list of compatible portable audio players go to:

Thousands of audio books, eBooks, music, and video titles are available for Phoenix valley library cardholders to download for use on their home computers, anytime – day or night. Digital audio books and eBooks can be used on a variety of devices such as PCs, laptops, and supported PDAs. Music and videos are also available for use on personal computers and portable devices. OverDrive Media Console software is freely available to play audio books, music and video titles. Adobe Reader and Mobipocket Reader are free software to view eBooks.

Getting Started

To access digital media titles at Greater Phoenix Digital Library, you will need:

- A valid library card
- Access to the Internet from your own personal computer
- Freely available software for the device on which you wish to use your audio book, ebook, music or video title

Download & Install Digital Book Software

As a first step, you will need to install free software on the machine(s) on which you want to use any of the digital media titles. The required software varies by format:

- [Adobe Reader](#) -- Required for reading Adobe eBooks. *Please note that Adobe Reader is not the same software as Adobe Acrobat.*

Register Your Free Software

Before you check out a digital book, you'll need to register your free software. You only need to register the software once for each machine on which you'll access digital books. Each format requires a different process for registering software:

Adobe Reader

There are two ways to register Adobe Reader, 'easy activation' and 'named activation.'

'Easy Activation' will automatically occur the first time you download and open an Adobe eBook. Once 'easy activation' is complete, you'll notice an Adobe confirmation screen. You can close this screen and proceed with your eBook download.

'Named Activation' allows you to read an Adobe eBook on multiple devices. To complete 'Named Activation,' do one of the following:

- If you are using Adobe Reader 6, open Adobe Reader and from the menu bar select *Tools > eBook Web Services > Adobe DRM Activator.*
- If you are using Adobe Reader 7, open Adobe Reader and from the menu bar select *File > Digital Editions > Authorize Devices.*

Mobipocket Reader

All copies of Mobipocket Reader have a unique registration number called a 'PID' (Personal Identifier). To register Mobipocket Reader, you need to sign into the Greater Phoenix Digital Library site using your library card number, and update your account information with your Mobipocket Reader PID(s). You can register up to three PIDs, enabling you to read eBooks on up to three devices.

OverDrive Media Console

OverDrive Media Console utilizes Windows Media Player 9 or 10 to play audio books, music, and video titles. OverDrive Media Console also performs the transfer of these titles to CDs and supported portable devices. Compatible portable devices are listed at: www.overdrive.com/deviceresourcecenter.

Check Out and Enjoy Digital Books

You can browse or search this site for downloadable eBooks and audio books. When you locate a title of interest, simply add it to your Digital BookBag and check out the title.

Once you have checked out the digital book, a download page will be displayed. Click the download link to download your digital book.

If the desired digital book is not available, you may place a hold on the title.
